

People United Foundation — Impact Reporting Framework (Aggregate-Only)

PUF is designed for procurement- and grant-friendly impact reporting:

- No accounts required (v1)
- No surveillance or individual tracking
- No behavioral scoring or profiling
- Reporting is aggregate and community-level

What we can report (examples)

- Participation (aggregate): totals started/completed, completion rate
- Delivery milestones: kickoff, midpoint update, wrap-up
- Program scope: programs included + cohort tier or enterprise license
- Community-level outcomes: narrative themes (no personal identifiers)

Recommended cadence: midpoint update (Week 3–4) + final report (Week 6–8).

Privacy statement: PUF does not require participant accounts and does not conduct surveillance or individual tracking. Reporting is aggregate and community-level, with no personal profiling.
