Summary

People United Foundation (PUF) provides ethics-first training programs in Workforce Readiness, Leadership, Governance, and Community & Economic Development.

PUF's approach is designed to be procurement- and grant-friendly:

- No surveillance or individual tracking
- No behavioral scoring or profiling
- No accounts required (v1)
- Reporting is aggregate and community-level

Deliverables (example)

- Course access for agreed number of seats OR cohort facilitation for agreed cohort size
- Sponsor packet and program materials
- Optional train-the-trainer enablement for facilitators
- Aggregate participation reporting (completion counts, participation totals)

Data & Privacy (sample clause)

PUF does not require participant accounts and does not conduct surveillance or individual tracking. Any reporting is aggregate and community-level, with no personal profiling.

Payment & Procurement

PUF supports invoice/PO workflows (ACH/check) upon request and can provide standard vendor onboarding documentation (e.g., W-9) if required.
